COURSE DESCRIPTION ...

This course will prepare law enforcement officers both mentally and physically when dealing with the use of deadly force. Sheriff Floyd has been involved personally with two separate shootings and will relive those moments in the training in order to prepare law enforcement for battle.

- Discussion of officer involved incidents using a firearm.
- Discussion on current, nationwide statistics in law enforcement officers killed and feloniously assaulted in the line of duty.
- Preparing mentally and physically for duty and/or potential combat. The class will discuss objectives in training, self-confidence, attitude, and understanding how law enforcement officers can develop their survival mindset.
- Discussion of current Supreme Court Rulings, deadly force levels, and provide reasoning on “Justification” and “Deadly Force”.
- Discussion on preparing an officer for the aftermath of an OIS such as the investigation, media, emotional support, agency support, protecting the officer’s civil rights, returning back to duty, and PTSD & PTSI.
- The course will also provide information on what law enforcement officers can do to keep their mind, body, and soul fit to overcome these obstacles in the field.
